- Play for fun.
- Work hard to improve your skills.

- Be on time for practices and games.
- Learn the rules and play by them. Always be a good sport.
- Respect your coach, your teammates, your parents, opponents and officials.
- Never argue with an official's decision.
- The locker room is for changing and building team unity.
 - Players are to conduct themselves with respect towards others. Greet every player as they come into the locker room in a positive manor.
 - No horseplay, destructive or harmful play.
 - Locker rooms are always to be left clean.
- When coaches begin instruction, on or off the ice, players are to stop all conversations and unnecessary activities (shooting loose pucks, etc) immediately and focus on the coach.
- Swearing or abusive language will not be tolerated and will result in lost game time at the first offense. Repeated offenses will be escalated to the Level Director.
- The following activities will result in immediate suspension and the player will be required to meet with the Level Director and Development VP before they will be allowed to play in a game situation.
 - Ejected from a game or scrimmage.
 - Any fighting, deliberate attempts to injure or blatant high sticking.
 - Players found to have been responsible for (or a party to) property damage or vandalism at the Burnsville Ice Center or at any team activity (including out-of-town tournaments).
- Be a positive example of Burnsville Hockey and to all those younger players who watch you.
